VILLAGE OF HOOSICK FALLS, NEW YORK Local Law #2 of the Local Laws of 2016 Schedule A

Section 1. Purpose.

It is the intent of the Village Board of Trustees of the Village of Hoosick Falls to promote the health, welfare and safety of the persons traveling on the Village's streets by changing certain sections of John Street within the Village limits of the Village of Hoosick Falls to no parking and providing the provisions for no parking signs to be erected on a portion of this street.

Section 2.

Hence forth, there will be no parking on the north and south sides of lower John Street beginning at Church Street, west for a distance of one hundred thirty-five (135') feet.

Section 3. Violation and Penalty.

Violation of any of the provisions of this local law shall be treated as a traffic infraction, and shall, upon conviction, be punishable by up to twenty-five (\$25.00) dollars fine and/or a term of imprisonment not to exceed fifteen (15) days in jail for the first offense, fifty (\$50.00) dollars fine and/or a term of imprisonment not to exceed thirty (30) days in jail for the second offense, and one hundred (\$100.00) dollars and/or a term of imprisonment not to exceed sixty (60) days in jail for each subsequent offense.

Section 4. Severability.

The provisions of this local law are declared to be severable. If any section, sentence, clause, phrase thereof shall for any reason be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decisions shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections, sentences, clauses, or phrases of this local law, but they shall remain in effect; it being the legislative intent that this local law shall remain in effect notwithstanding the validity of any part.

Section 5. Effective Date.

This local law shall become effective upon filing in the office of the Secretary of State.

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
