Local State of Emergency Proclamation

A **State of Emergency** is hereby declared in the **Village of Hoosick Falls** for a period of time beginning at 8PM on Saturday, July 1st and continuing in effect for a period (not to exceed five (5) days) ending at 8PM on Thursday, July 6th.

The State of Emergency has been declared due to emergency conditions produced by:

- Severe flooding in multiple parts of the Village.
 - Flooding has covered multiple roads, causing damage to roads and making driving impossible.
 - Flood waters are nearly overtaking one portion of the train track that drives through the Village.
 - Multiple houses are reporting flooding in their basement, and some in their first floor residence.
 - Roads coming into the Village have been reported to be blocked due to flood waters.

Such conditions threaten or imperil the public safety of the citizens of this municipality. As Chief Executive of this municipality, I have exercised the authority given to me under New York State Executive Law, Article 2-B, to preserve the public safety and hereby render all required and available assistance vital to the security, well-being and health of the citizens of the Village.

I hereby direct the Highway Department, Water & Sewer Departments, Police Department, as well as local Fire Departments and EMS, to take whatever steps necessary to protect life and property, public infrastructure and other such emergency assistance as deemed necessary.
