An ordinance regulating the parking of motor vehicles on public streets within the Village of Hoosick Falls, New York, during a declared snow emergency

Section 1. When ever the accumulation of snow is of such a nature as to impede the normal and safe movement of motor vehicles, the Mayor, duputy Mayor or Chief of Police may, in his descretion, declare a snow emergency.

Section 2. Whenever a snow emergency has been declared pursuant to section 1 herein, the Mayor, Duputy Mayor or Chief of Police may restrict the parking of motor vehicles upon the pyblic roads within the Village of Hoosick Falls, to parking either on the side of the street designated by the United States Post Office Department with even number for postal delivery or to the side of the street designated by the United States Post Office Department with odd numbers for postal delivery.

Section 3. Whenever a snow emergency has been declared, the village shall have notification (call tv and radio stations) of such snow emergency and emergency parking regulations by posting signs advising of such emergency and emergency parking regulation at the north and south entrance to the Village of Hoosick Falls on Main Street and at River Street entrance to the Village of Hoosick Falls and at such other places as the official declaring said emergency may, in his descretion, deem just and proper.

Section 4. Whenever a snow emergency has been declared, the official making such declaration may designate, in addition to parking regulations promulgated pursuant to section 2 of the within ordinance, no parking zones, tow away zones and one way streets in order to facilitate the proper movement of vehicular traffic within said village limits.

Section 5. Notification of any such emergency parking or traffic regulation shall be given by posting in the area so regulated a sign, or signs setting forth the emergency regulation.

Section 6. Whenever any motor vehicle is parked or abandoned in an area designed as a no parking area during a declared snow emergency, the village highway department shall remove or cause to be removed, said motor vihicle from the roadway by towing or other means, and any and all charges, cost or expense for towing, removal an storing of such motor vehicle shall be the obligation of the owner of said vehicle and shall be paid for by said owner if posted by snow removal signs.

Section 7. Any person or persons violating any of the provisions of this ordinance or any of its sections shall ,upon conviction, forfeit and pay a fine of not more than \$50.00. Adopted January 27, 1970 effective February 15, 1970
